Principal's Report - Hans Becker

- Sophomores will be taking the PSAT on Wednesday as well as Juniors if they signed up
- This is our WASC year and we are on a 6-year review Last Friday met with the WASC coordinator who will be leading a team of 7 other people.
- Football game this Friday night Homecoming against La Jolla had a meeting with the neighbors last week (5 neighbors signed up). The Voltaire gate will be closed for this game. Off site parking will be at the library and other places handicap lots will be open for the elderly (basketball courts).
- New asphalt in front of the library instead of dirt. The art department may be contacted to do some work on it to make it look better.

- Cement patches and cement seals are being done for safety reasons
- Met with architects this last week and some rough ideas were presented to replace the media center
- Some of the site master plan funding was paying for the Dana Field so Phase II on the Dana Field may not be exactly what was originally proposed (District funds are paying for the project)
- PLHS has been award the Assets Grant for the next 5 years for after school programs. An outside source company (ARC) has been selected and board of Ed will be approving hopefully. After school tutoring will be happening this week. Targeting math (integrated Math I and Math II)

- Pointer Association total funds on account = \$322,694 (these include all Booster accounts and alumni accounts and anything under the PA umbrella) Non-earmarked (PA discretionary) funds = \$29,037 (this will be used for fall AAA's).
- There is great documentation regarding AAA from the spring and spending accountability.
