REPORT:

Open House will be Sept. 21, Homecoming Oct. 28. The dates for next year's PTSA meetings will be the same—2nd Mondays @6:00 p.m. She also reminded us to save any

Stumps receipts, as they will donate a portion of their sales to PLHS.

TREASURER'S/ REPORT: Darlene Truver distributed the treasurer's reports for December and January. **B. Coyne** made a motion to approve both month's expenses and reports M/A. Cheryl Louie provided a statement indicating she did an audit of the books from July – December 2005,

and reported that all is in order.

MEMBERSHIP: Tracey Smedley reported receipts of ~\$8,500, of which ~\$6,500 stays at PLHS. 75% of the
