## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Alumni,

I have enjoyed getting acquainted with many of Point Loma High School's alumni, all of whom have exhibited pride, interest, and support in our school. The community spirit of students, staff, and parents has been evidenced in many ways, including our community Kick-Off event held on Sept. 19th. The Alumni Classes of 1946, 1947, and 1948 have contributed funds toward our Booster Club and toward a new school marquee, which should be installed sometime second semester. The P.T.A.--which includes many alumni, the Booster Club, Penninsula Bank, and community organizations have raised or donated money for school projects such as the marquee, a PA system for the field, and a picture of our 1987 State Championship Girls' Basketball Team for the gym.

In addition to our State
Championship in Basketball, Point
Loma has received honors in many
areas this past year. These
include a state winner of the
Science Fair, being named a Naval
Honor School (NJROTC), nominated
for Distinguished Schools Award
based on the state's Quality
Indicators report (one of only
three San Diego City Schools),
three year approval for our Gifted

and Talented Education Plan (the only San Diego City high school), reduction by over 30% per month it our nonapportioned absences and truancies, increase in our Spanish magnet enrollment by approximately 50%, a pass rate of over 90% on the Advance Placement Spanish tests, and many other individual awards by our students.

We are proud of our school and community and know that through our combined efforts we will continue, and enhance, the "Point Loma Pride".

#### OPINION POLL


