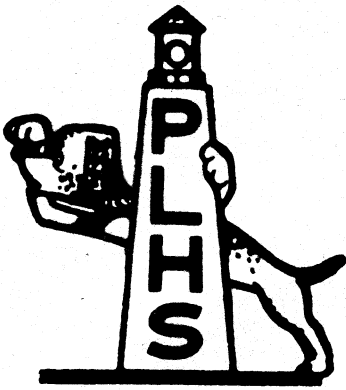

The library needs two more computer stations for the new automated check-out/card catalog system. The estimated cost is \$1,500 per station. Please contact the library.

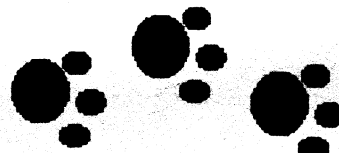
# Coach's Corner

## Spring Sports End At PLHS, Coach Bennie Edens

Spring sports ended at Point Loma High with a strong finish. Our boys Volleyball team qualified for the Playoffs for the first time and though they lost their first round match, the team showed marked improvement over past years. Girls and boys Track had a mediocre year but standouts Gilbert Serrono and Susana Pienado challenged the best distance runners in the section. Golf was lead by Steve Griswold, who finished 2nd in the league and went to the final day in CIF individual play. Swimming, both boys and girls, raised enough money to field a team and Joe Torres competed all the way to the CIF finals.

Softball, an all underclass team, was almost there--as freshman pitching sensation Cathy Yamashiro proved she will be a strong force for the next three years. 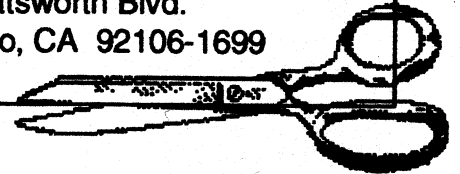
