This year marked the 70th birthday of Point Loma High and the 70th birthday of our head football coach and athletic director, Bennie Edens. Thanks to the hard work of a dedicated group of alumni and parents, we held a party to celebrate these two birthdays. Nearly 800 alumni, parents, and friends attended. It was a great evening filled with reunions and the sharing of wonderful memories. We raised over \$50,000, which will be used to refurbish our gymnasium. This event was very representative of the tradition, continuity and involvement that are such an integral aspect of Point Loma High.

On June 13, 1996, 395 students will receive their diplomas and join the ranks of Point Loma High alumni. Seventy-one percent of this class have indicated that they plan to further their education. Students in the class of '96 will be attending colleges in over 37 states. Some of the schools they are attending include Stanford, Naval Academy, UC Berkeley, Oberlin and Georgetown they have received over a half million dollars in grants and scholarships. They will be wonderful representatives of Point Loma High.

Sports participation at Point Loma High School reached an all time high during the 1995-96 school year. Many young men and young women enjoyed and benefited from interscholastic competition. The enjoyment of participation is emphasized and many fond memories will be part of their high school years. Once again "The Point" was highly competitive in most sports, finishing in the upper half of the league and winning five championships. Several athletes have received scholarships and more are expected before the end of the school year. Two former Pointer athletes signed with the NFL. Dan White ('91) signed with the Houston Oilers while LaRoi Glover ('92) was drafted by the Oakland Raiders. "The Point" now has five players in the NFL

The spring sports include badminton, baseball, gold, girls softball, swimming, boys tennis, track and boys volleyball. Boys volleyball led by Colin Bowles were co-champions and have won their first round playoff game. Softball finished in second place and are getting ready for the playoffs.

Cathy Yamashiro is one of the best pitchers in the section and has broken most of Point Loma's pitching records. Golf had the Eastern League Player of the Year in George Pramas and two other all-leaguers in Tim Dunbar and Anthony Payne. Baseball was led by Benji Solano and finished in fourth place even after losing their two top pitchers to broken bones. Track has one girl in C.I.F. Nicole Johnson, a discus thrower, while the boys have two milers, Celso Fernandez and David Haynes. Tennis had an 8 and 7 record and were led by Chris Link in singles and Willie Klees and John Wertz in doubles.


Introducing *Pointer Commemorative*Pavers! Here is the perfect opportunity to cement your place in PLHS's history.
