Meet New Principal Bobbie Samilson

A Brief Biography

Barbara Samilson, or "Bobbie", as she is known, graduated with B.A. in Biology from Denison University in Ohio and began her career in education with a teaching credential from California State University at Sacramento.

She began teaching in 1981 at Cabrillo Elementary School in Point Loma. From there she went to Stockton (now King) Elementary in San Diego and then MacDowell Elementary in Clairemont. From 1984 – 1994 Samilson worked at Jerabek Elementary in Scripps Ranch as a GATE teacher, GATE Team leader and Mentor Teacher. Thereafter she taught for six years at Wangenheim Middle School in Mira Mesa before becoming its Vice Principal.

After just a year at Wangenheim, she was selected as the new principal for Ray Kroc Middle School where she served for the next three years. During that time she served as a Mentor Principal for the Educational Leadership Development Academy at the University of San Diego.

During this past summer Samilson was awarded the title of Principal of Point Loma High School after Mike Price moved to a new position with the District.

"I'm thrilled to be here," says Samilson. "Mike Price did a great job and I look forward to continuing his tradition of excellence."


